Submission Guidelines

1. All submissions should be formatted according to the guidelines of the American Sociological Review (ASR) Style Guide.
2. Papers should include an abstract that is normally between 50-75 words.
3. Papers are normally 10-25 pages in length (including references, tables, charts, etc.).
4. Text of the paper should be double-spaced in Times New Roman 12 point font.
5. All submissions should be sent electronically via e-mail attachment. No mailed disks will be accepted.
6. The manuscript should be submitted in an MS Word file.
7. Three attachments should be sent with the submission:
 - a. A cover letter to the managing editor(s) expressing intent.
 - b. The manuscript with no identifying names or affiliations.
 - c. A cover page with the names and affiliations of the author(s) including contact information.
8. Place all tables, charts, photos, etc. in the body of the text, not at the end of the manuscript.
